# Experts on estate planning to keynote Annual Meeting

Two legal experts on estate planning will be the keynote speakers at the April 25 annual meeting of the VCCCD Retirees' Association.

Their presentation is titled "A Taste of Estate Planning."

Paul Morison and his partner, Christopher Botti, will focus primarily on the revocable living trust as an estate planning vehicle.

They will describe the hazards of probate in California and how to avoid it, the advantages and disadvantages of living trusts versus wills, how to reduce taxes through proper estate planning, powers of attorney for health care decisions, physician directives or "living wills," and other estate planning issues.

They will also answer questions from the audience, distribute printed informational materials, and extend an invitation to attend "full blown" workshops that will be scheduled locally soon after the annual meeting.

Our keynote speakers are principals of the firm Botti and Morison, Estate Planning Attorneys, with eight offices in Central and Southern California, including offices in Ventura and Westlake Village.

Both Botti and Morison received their law degrees from Whittier College School of Law, where both served as editors of the Whittier Law Review.

## Annual Meeting set for April 25

Mark your calendars! The annual meeting of the VCCCD Retirees' Association is coming April 25.

The meeting will be held at the Ventura County Office of Education Conference Center, 5100 Adolfo Rd., in Camarillo.

President Harry Culotta will call the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m.

The agenda includes election of new officers for the association and two proposed changes to the Bylaws (detailed elsewhere in this newletter).

They have specialized in estate planning for almost two decades.

In addition to the keynote address, the annual meeting's agenda includes having retirees vote for officers to lead the VCCCD Retirees Association for the next two years, as the terms of all four elected officers (president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer) will expire on June 30, 2012.

The Association secretary and treasurer have indicated their willingness to stand for re-election to another two-year term, but there will be the need to elect a new president and vice-president.

VCCCD Retirees' Association President Harry Culotta has been selected to serve on the 21-member search committee to find a new chancellor for the college district.

Dr. James Meznek, chancellor since July 2004, has announced that he will retire in June or July 2012.

The Chancellor Search Committee is chaired by Patricia Parham, Vice Chcancellor, Human Resources, and is assisted by Dr. James Walker and Dr. John Romo of Community College Search Services.

Culotta, a resident of Ven-

tura, was appointed by Steven Blum, Chair of the VCCCD Board of Trustees, as his community representative.

"I'm pleased and honored to be asked to help with the search for the district's next chancellor," Culotta said.

The Chancellor's Search Committee has already drafted a brochure

Following an approximately two-month recruitment process, the Committee will interview candidates in May, then forward its recommendations to the Board of Trustees for final interviews and action in June.

Finally, the association's Executive Board will ask retirees to approve minor revisions to two sections of the *Bylaws of the VCCCD Retirees' Association*, as follows (with new language in *italics*).

#### **Article III - MEMBERS**

Section 3. There shall be no initiation fee. The board shall recommend annual *AND LIFETIME* dues. The amount(*S*) *ARE* to be

voted upon by the members at a general meeting.

Dues were reduced to \$10.00 per year beginning July 1, 1998.

#### Article IV - OFFICERS

Section 7. The duties of the Treasurer shall be:

e. To prepare *budgets*, financial reports, and annual statements.
